Visitor Rules of ZOO Wrocław LLC (hereinafter ZOO Wrocław or zoo)

I. General Provisions

- 1. These regulations are publicly available at the entrance to the zoo and on its official website.
- 2. Entry is permitted only to individuals holding a valid admission ticket or annual pass.
- 3. Purchased admission tickets must be retained at all times and shown upon request
- 4. Children under the age of 10 years must be accompanied by an adult
- 5. Visitors are obliged to comply with the applicable law, these Rules, signs and information boards located in the zoo, as well as instructions from the staff of ZOO Wrocław
- 6. ZOO Wrocław is not responsible for accidents and damages resulting from non-compliance with the Visitor Rules
- 7. Visitors are financially responsible for any damage or loss they cause. Parents / legal guardians are liable for all damages and losses caused by their minor children
- 8. Persons who do not comply with the regulations may be removed from the zoo premises
- 9. Zoo staff may request assistance from municipal guards or the police in enforcing the regulations

II. Strictly Prohibited on ZOO Wrocław grounds

- 1. Enter or stay in the zoo beyond opening hours
- 2. Bringing in any type of motor vehicle without permission
- 3. Entering with or using bicycles, rollerblades, scooters, skateboards, or similar equipment
- 4. Bringing animals, except certified assistance dogs as defined by law.
- 5. Bringing balloons, balls, kites, or similar objects
- 6. Entering under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicants
- 7. Consuming alcohol outside designated areas (e.g. zoo restaurants)
- 8. Smoking (including electronic cigarettes) outside designated smoking zones
- 9. Leaving designated visitor paths
- 10. Entering animal enclosures or non-public areas
- 11. Touching electric fences

- 12. Climbing over fences or barriers, feeding animals, or extending body parts or objects into enclosures
- 13. Standing or placing children on protective barriers
- 14. Tapping on glass at exhibits
- 15. Climbing on architectural elements, decorations, or trees
- 16. Harassing, feeding, or disturbing animals
- 17. Littering or generating excessive noise
- 18. Using flash photography
- 19. Using lasers, drones, or remote-controlled toys
- 20. Damaging greenery, infrastructure, or installations
- 21. Entering or swimming in ponds, fountains, or other water features

III. Additional Restrictions

It is forbidden to:

- 1. Conduct trade, marketing, or to offer services without ZOO Wrocław authorization
- 2. Organize events without written permission from the zoo
- 3. Film or photograph for commercial purposes without approval
- 4. Use ZOO Wrocław photos or videos for commercial purposes without consent
- 5. Bring in fireworks, firearms, or ammunition

IV. Other Provisions

- 1. The current price list for admission tickets and annual passes is available at ticket counters and on the ZOO Wrocław's website www.zoo.wroclaw.pl.
- 2. The zoo's opening hours are displayed on-site and published online.
